PACKAGE CONTENTS

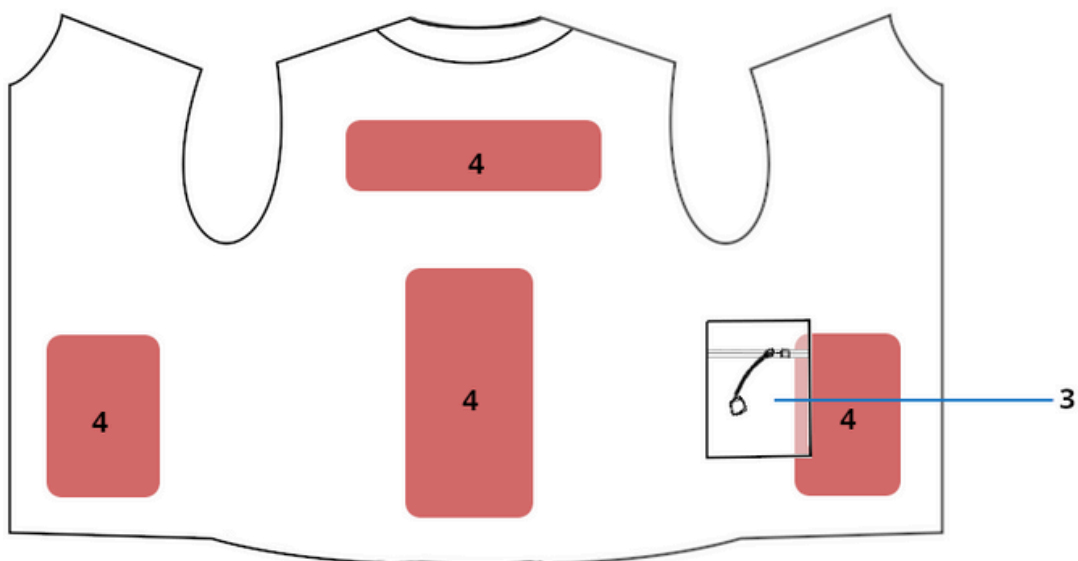
1x insulated vest with heating elements and dual USB ends (type A and type C at 5V/3A)

1x detachable hood cap with cord adjustment

1x Battery Pack with 10000mAh capacity

1. Power button and heat level controller. (Red- high, White- medium, Blue- low)
2. Outer Pockets
3. Powerbank (detachable) and power cables pocket
4. Heating elements location (blown up inner diagram)

HEATING ZONES



The Varme vest is primarily designed to be used as a mid-layer.

We recommend that you turn on the heat before you feel cold, as a preventative measure. If you first get very cold, the body requires a lot of energy to regain heat.

USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

The battery should be fully charged before first use, or after a long period (2 months or more) of no use.

Plug In: Connect the USB plug (located in left inner pocket) to the battery pack or the motorcycle's USB charging socket (smartphone charging socket)

Turn On: Gently press the FRONT LOGO button until the light is on.

Adjust: Single press the button to switch heating levels between High (~65°C), Medium (~55°C) and Low (~45°C).

Turn Off: Press & hold the button for 3 seconds until the light is off or disconnect the USB from the battery pack.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Remember to remove battery before washing, and follow the instructions carefully, to ensure maximum lifespan of your heated vest.

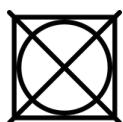
- Remove the power bank from the vest pocket before washing, and put the USB plug back to the pocket and zip up.
- Gentle hand wash with a mild detergent and cold water.
- Hang dry recommended.
- Do not wring or twist. Do not Iron, Bleach or Dry Clean.
- Never immerse your battery in liquid or allow liquid to flow inside.

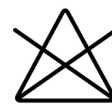

BATTERY INSTRUCTIONS

Press the power button, the battery will turn off. To turn it back on, simply single press the power button or unplug & re-plug in the USB.

CHARGING :

- Single press the button to check the remaining power level or charging level from 5 LED indicators.
- Plug the USB cable into the input port on the power bank. Attach the other end, usually a standard USB, into a wall charger or other USB power source.
- Fully charged when the 5 LED indicators turn on.

BATTERY STORAGE :

- Store a fully charged battery in a cool dry place.
- Re-charge the battery after long periods of storing time.
- Do not expose the battery to rain or snow.
- Do not freeze or immerse the battery in water or any other liquid.
- Do not dry the battery with an external heat source such as a microwave oven or hair dryer.
- Do not drop, disassemble, open, crush, bend, deform, puncture, shred, microwave, incinerate or paint the battery.
- Do not store your battery with metal objects, such as coins, keys or necklaces. If the battery terminals come in contact with metal objects, this may cause a fire.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not use this heated vest with an infant, child, a helpless person, or anyone insensitive to heat, such as a person with poor blood circulation.
- Not recommended for anyone with medical condition making them sensitive to overheating, or persons who use any personal medical devices.
- Never use if inner liner is wet.
- Not recommended to wear over bare skin.
- Do not store your smartphone in the vest pocket when using heating system.
- Turn off power immediately if discomfort occurs.
- If improper operation of this heated vest is observed, discontinue its use immediately and contact our customer service for assistance.
